A resolution to establish 2 worship services

The Unitarian Universalist Fellowship of Central Oregon (UUFCO) makes the following findings:

1. Congregational growth is rapid and ongoing with membership having almost doubled in the past 3 years.
2. Average attendance at Sunday services is 250 which is at near capacity for the sanctuary space.
3. An all-congregational meeting was held January 2018. Findings from the meeting showed the congregation is committed to welcoming new members and expanding our presence in our community.
4. The population growth of Bend and central Oregon is rapid and predicted to continue.
5. The Board authorized on _____ the establishment of a growth task force to study congregational growth. The recommendation of the task force is to move to a two Sunday service schedule.
6. The 2018-2019 budget supports the addition of a second service.

Therefore, the UUFCO Board resolves as follows:

1. The Board resolves to establish a task force to determine the initial plan for developing and implementing 2 services.
2. The board resolves to delegate the authority to the Minister to carry out the details of implementation and review.
3. The Board resolves to review periodic reports from the Minister and growth task force after the start of a 2 service schedule.

This resolution takes effect immediately upon adoption.
